## HOUSE EXECUTIVE MESSAGE NO. 52

Dear Speaker Egolf and Members of the House:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of House Bill 263, which provides guidance with respect to the purposes of probation and parole; clarifies the duties of the Corrections Department under the Probation and Parole Act; changes certain definitions applicable to the Probation and Parole Act; clarifies the information to be provided in a presentence report under Section 31-21-9 NMSA; alters conditions pertaining to intensive supervision programs under Section 31-21-13.1 NMSA; changes certain requirements pertaining to probation and parole violations; requires the Department of Corrections to implement a "medical and geriatric parole program" that conforms with certain requirements; requires the Adult Probation and Parole Division of the Corrections Department to implement an incentives and sanctions system that provides for graduated responses to technical violations; and imposes new requirements for technical violations.
