Dear Speaker Egolf and Members of the House:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of House Bill 269, which clarifies duties of the Homeland Security and Emergency Management Department; adds definitions to the Antiterrorism Act and the Computer Crimes Act; creates the crimes of terrorism, possessing a terroristic weapon, making a terroristic threat, and cyberterrorism, and provides for penalties attendant thereto; and requires reporting and information sharing concerning cyberterrorism, terroristic threats, and terrorist acts.
