Dear President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:


Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(B)(2) of the New Mexico Constitution, I am authorizing for your consideration during the Fifty-Fourth Legislature, Second Session, submission of Senate Bill 111, which removes the requirement for employees and employers to make nonrefundable contributions for retired employees who return to employment at a level of one-fourth or less full-time employee; allows retirees to return to work without a suspension of their retirement benefits under certain conditions; and exempts employees considered to be substitutes from the requirements of the Educational Retirement Act.
